



Oxford Science Studies - ENTZ

Oxford Science Studies are looking for Entertainment Team Members (ENTZ) to work on their educational courses, for students aged between 14 and 19. This role is for casual work, with hours mainly being worked in the evenings (approx. 18:45 - 22.45) of the Easter, Summer and Christmas school holidays in Oxford. The position is flexible so you do not have to work on every course, or the entire course. Depending on the specific task, team members may work on their own or in a group of up to approximately 8 staff and report to the Residential Programme Manager.

Duties include:

- Being responsible for the entertainment and safety of students after lessons and during the evening
- Assisting and ensuring the evening entertainment is set up in a timely and well organised manner, in line with the course requirements
- Supervising and encouraging students to participate in activities and take part themselves
- Ensuring students are behaving appropriately

Activities may include: bowling, cinema trips, dining out, sport and quizzes.

You can be involved during the day (approx. 09:00 – 17:00) with the setting up and tidying up of courses, helping with student arrivals, booking activities and occasional day time tasks, such as helping during meal/break times. There is also an opportunity to be part of our night patrol team (23:00 – 01:00) where you will be patrolling boarding houses and the campus to ensure students are safe.

Requirements:

- Have excellent communication skills
- Being able to work alone or with a team
- Be reliable and flexible
- Be able to show initiative
- Successful completion of an enhanced DBS check

Please note that Entz team members will be self-employed and paid at an hourly rate of £8.
